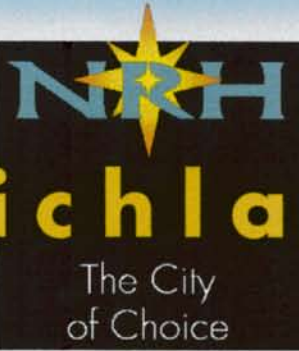

NRH Public Safety Fair

Through state regulations and the Public Information Act, the City of North Richland Hills is required to post agendas for meetings so residents know the issues their City Officials are contemplating before being voted upon. Agendas are placed in several locations throughout the city, on the city's cable channel 7, and on the city's web site for residents to view at their convenience. The city is required to post agendas and public hearings in a determined amount of time as stated by the law.

City Council and Planning and Zoning agendas are posted at least

seventy-two hours before the next scheduled meeting. City Council agendas are posted on the city's web site (www.ci.north-richland-hills.tx.us) and the city's cable channel 7 the Friday before the regular scheduled meeting on the second or fourth Monday of the month. These agendas are additionally posted at City Hall in the lobby of the Administration building and the lobby of the Police Department (which is open twenty-four hours daily). Planning and Zoning agendas are posted the Monday prior to the regular scheduled meeting on the second or fourth Thursday of the month. Additionally, all of the city's

boards and commission meetings are posted at least seventy-two hours prior to the actual meeting. These agendas are posted at City Hall and in the lobby of the Police Department.

Public Hearing's are also required to be posted so residents can attend the meeting to voice their opinion regarding the issue. Public Hearing's are published in the legal notice section of the Star-Telegram. Zoning Public Hearings must be published at least ten days prior to the Planning and Zoning meeting and at least fifteen days prior to the City Council meeting. The information published provides the issue being discussed,
